



NEW PRESENTER JOINS NORTH NORFOLK RADIO

North Norfolk's very own radio station, North Norfolk Radio, is expanding its presentation team with the appointment of Kelvin Scott as a new Daytime presenter.

Kelvin will join the existing team including Dick Hutchinson, Graham Lewis and Greg Powles.

Kelvin's new Daytime show between 10 and 3 will be broadcast live from the station's studios on Breck Farm in Stody near Holt, starting on Monday March 21st.
